RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE DEVELOPMENT OF AN UNDERGROUND NUCLEAR WASTE FACILITY

a Canadian power company is proposing to develop an underground WHEREAS, nuclear waste facility near Kincardine, Ontario; and,

the proposed facility would be situated less than 1 mile from the Lake WHEREAS, Huron shoreline; and,

WHEREAS, storing low and intermediate level waste so close to Lake Huron, which constitutes 21% of the world's fresh water supply, may jeopardize the fragile ecosystem and is a risk that cannot be afforded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lapeer County Board of Commissioners hereby opposes the development of an underground nuclear waste facility, near Kincardine, Ontario because of the risk of polluting the Great Lakes and upsetting the ecosystem; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this Resolution be forwarded to State[§] Representative Kevin Daley, State Senator Phil Pavlov, State Senator Mike Green, Congresswoman Candice Miller, U.S. Senators Carl Levin and Debbie Stabenow, Governor Rick Snyder, as well as the Michigan Association of Counties.
